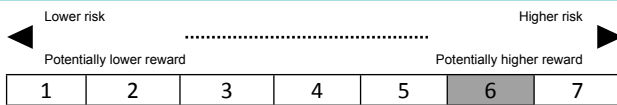
The management company is DWS Investment GmbH, a member of the DWS Group.

### Objectives and investment policy

The fund is actively managed. The fund is managed in reference to a benchmark. The objective of the investment policy is to achieve sustained capital appreciation relative to the benchmark (EURO STOXX (Net Return)). To achieve this, the fund invests at least 75% of its assets in equities that are denominated in euros. Derivatives may be acquired for investment and hedging purposes. In that context, the fund management is responsible for selecting the individual investments. The majority of the fund's securities or their issuers are expected to be components of the benchmark. The fund management will use its discretion to invest in securities and sectors that are not included in the benchmark in order to take advantages of specific investment opportunities. It is expected that

the portfolio will have a similar weighting to the benchmark. The positioning of the fund can deviate from the benchmark to a limited extent (e.g., by holding positions that are not contained in the benchmark, as well as by an underweighting or overweighting). The actual leeway in this respect is normally relatively low. Despite the fact that the fund aims to outperform the benchmark, the potential outperformance might be limited depending on the prevailing market environment (e.g. less volatile market environment) and actual positioning versus the benchmark. The currency of the fund is EUR. Returns and gains are not distributed but are reinvested in the fund. You may request the redemption of shares generally on a daily basis.

### Risk and reward profile



The calculation of the risk and reward profile is based on simulated data that cannot be used as a reliable indicator for the future risk profile. This risk indicator is subject to changes; the classification of the fund may change over time and cannot be guaranteed. Even a fund that is classified in the lowest category (category 1) does not represent a completely risk-free investment. The fund is classified in category 6 because its share price may fluctuate strongly and

The following risks could be of particular significance for the fund: The fund uses derivatives on underlyings so as to participate in their increases in value or to bet on their losses in value. The increased opportunities associated with this are accompanied by increased risk of loss. Furthermore, derivative transactions may be used to hedge the fund's assets. The use of derivative transactions for hedging purposes may reduce the fund's upside opportunities. The fund invests in equities. Equities are subject to strong price fluctuations and thus also to the risk of price decreases. 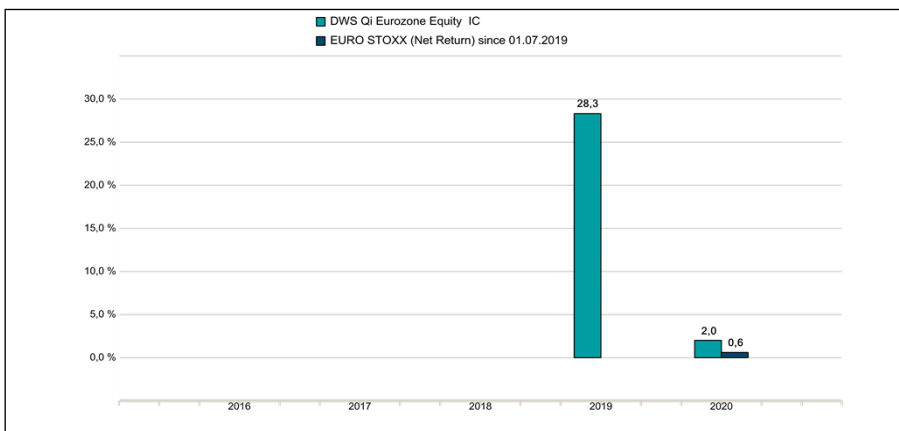
### Charges
