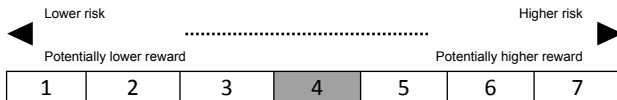
The management company is DWS Investment GmbH, a member of the DWS Group.

### Objectives and investment policy

The fund is actively managed. The fund is not managed in reference to a benchmark. The objective of the investment policy is to achieve sustained capital appreciation. In order to achieve this, the fund invests predominantly in hybrid bonds. Hybrid bonds are equity-like subordinated corporate bonds with very long maturities or with no limitation on maturity that be terminated by the issuer as

of a date defined in advance. In terms of their nature, they lie between equities and fixed-interest securities. The selection of the individual investments is at the discretion of the fund management. The currency of the fund is EUR. Returns and gains are not distributed but are reinvested in the fund. You may request the redemption of shares generally on a daily basis.

### Risk and reward profile



The calculation of the risk and reward profile is based on simulated data that cannot be used as a reliable indicator for the future risk profile. This risk indicator is subject to changes; the classification of the fund may change over time and cannot be guaranteed. Even a fund that is classified in the lowest category (category 1) does not represent a completely risk-free investment. The fund is classified in category 4 because its share price fluctuates and the likelihood of both losses and gains may therefore be relatively high. The

following risks could be of particular significance for the fund: The fund invests in contingent convertible bonds. Compared to traditional bonds, this type of bond may be more likely to result in partial or complete loss of value. An investment in this special type of bond may result in substantial losses for the portfolio due to certain trigger events. Bonds of this type can also be converted into equities of the issuing company, which may also suffer a loss in value. The fund invests in bonds, the value of which depends on whether the issuer is able to afford its payments. The deterioration of credit quality (ability and willingness to repay) may have an adverse affect on the value of the bond.

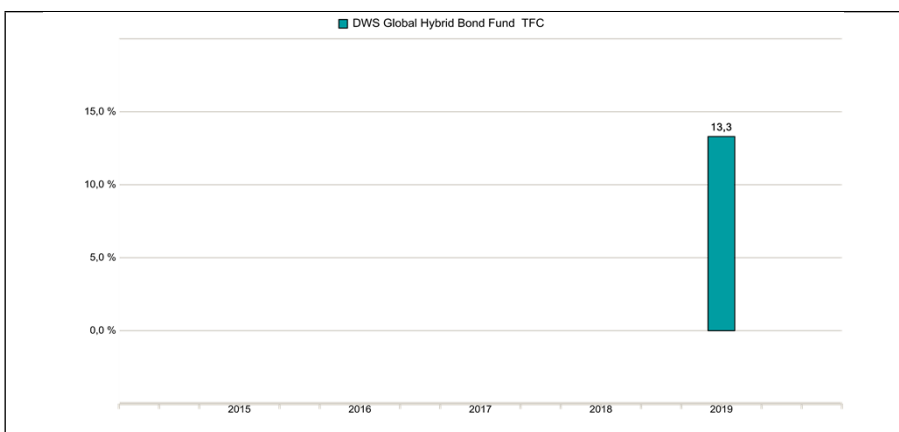
The charges you pay are used to pay the costs of running the fund, including the costs of marketing and distributing it. These charges reduce the potential growth of your investment.
